


## **PRIVACY STATEMENT – EASY ENGLISH**


This privacy statement explains your rights and how we manage your personal information.




KinKera Community makes sure it does the right thing and must comply with the Privacy Act 1988 and the NDIS Act 2013.



To provide services to you, we need to know certain information about you. We call this Personal Information.




Personal Information includes things like your name, your address, your phone number, your email address.



We need your Personal Information to be able to understand your needs and make



sure our property can meet your needs.




When we ask you for your information, we will tell you why we need the information and how we will use it.



Sometimes, we may need to get information about you from your other support providers.



We may need to give your information to other people. We only do this if we have to, to keep you safe, if you tell us it is ok, or if we have to by law.



We will keep your information safe. When we don't need your information anymore, we will destroy it.




You can have access to your Personal Information that we have. You can ask us to access your information.







Sometimes we may not be able to give you access to your Personal Information. We will explain to you why if this happens.
